Junior Handler Participation Waiver and Release

Juniors will run the same courses the other competitors (under the same judge) and will get veteran times. Junior handler Qs are available in all classes at all three levels. A dog running in a standard class with a JH cannot also run in the same class for "dog Qs" with a different handler. Qs earned by the JH toward JH titles do not also count toward the dog's title. A dog running with a junior can also be entered in other classes with another handler for Qs that will count toward the dog's titles, but in no case can a dog run the same course twice. (Whether a dog is being entered for JH Qs or dog Qs must be indicated on the entry form.)

Juniors must have their entry waivers signed by a parent or guardian. To earn Qs toward a junior title, juniors must have a junior handler ID card, available for download from the AAC web site (www.aac.ca). Juniors may run different dogs at different trials and have their Qs count toward JH titles, provided they enter as a JH each time. (That is, the Qs accumulate to the handler, not the dog.) Dogs run by juniors for JH Qs can run at one jump height lower than the height at which they normally compete.

Covid-19 Health and Safety Protocol

Due to COVID-19 we have had to change many aspects of our daily lives. The same is true for agility. At Daytripper our goal is to host agility trials that are as safe as possible for all in attendance. We have been carefully researching and planning; constantly searching for the most current information. We will be complying with the Ontario Government's guidelines regarding the virus. If there is a change in those guidelines that prevents us from hosting a trial, we will notify competitors by email and your payment will not be processed.

Below is a non-exhaustive list of changes to our trial format. This list is subject to change as new information about the virus becomes available.

1. Do not come if you have any of the following conditions:
 - Cough, fever, unexplained new or worsening:
 - Sneezing
 - Shortness of breath
 - Nausea vomiting or diarrhea
 - Muscle aches
 - Fatigue, general malaise
 - Conjunctivitis
 - Loss of smell or taste
 - Have travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days. Have an unprotected exposure to a patient with COVID-19 or symptoms consistent with COVID-19. You have been advised to isolate by a Public Health Authority
2. Parking and tenting: There is ample space on the property. Please be sure to leave a minimum of six feet between vehicles and tents.
3. Spectators are limited to one per competitor, preferably from the same household.
4. Physical distancing is in effect throughout the property. This also applies to crating under the shade tree.
5. Competitors are required to bring face masks that fully cover their nose, mouth and chin.
6. Competitors are required to sanitize their hands before and after measuring, and wear face masks during measuring.
7. Judge's Briefings and Course Walkthroughs: Competitors must wear face masks during Judge's briefings and when walking the course. Walkthroughs may be split into two, if required. Face masks are optional when running your dog.
8. There will be hand sanitizer outside of the Hangar. Please use it before entering and upon exiting the hangar.
9. Physical distancing is in effect in the Hangar (our grey outbuilding) and face masks are required. This is not only for the safety of competitors but also our judges and scorekeeper. Please do not congregate in the Hangar. Due to the size of the hangar, there should be a maximum of two competitors in the hangar at a time. Thank you for your co-operation. Weather permitting results, helper sign-up sheet, volunteer gifts, etc will be outside.
10. Course maps: Copies of course maps will not be available for competitors. Course maps will be posted on a board outside the Hangar. Competitors are encouraged to take pictures of their course maps, then move away from the board. Physical distancing is in effect – do not congregate at the board. Please allow all competitors safe access to the board while practicing physical distancing.
11. There will be no snacks or beverages available at the trials.
12. Feel free to bring your own hand sanitizer. There will be sanitizer in various locations on the trial site. Use hand sanitizer to thoroughly disinfect your hands throughout the day, being sure to cover

palms, backs of hands and between fingers. Please do not use disposable gloves. They are not recommended due to the high risk of cross-contamination.

13. Porta Potty: There will be hand sanitizer on a table outside the porta potty. Please use it before and after using the porta potty and prop the door open after use. We recommend you wear a face mask while in the porta potty.
14. Ring crew: Please use hand sanitizer before entering and upon exiting the ring. Disposable gloves are not recommended due to cross contamination.
15. Ribbons: We are currently in discussion about the safest way to address ribbons. More info will be available either prior to or at the trial.
16. Please do not leave used PPE, dog treats, dog toys, water bottles or anything else you have handled around the trial site.

We understand that these guidelines may seem restrictive and it may be challenging to avoid old habits and the usual camaraderie we all enjoy at agility trials. Please know that keeping all competitors, judges, the volunteers, and ourselves safe and healthy is of utmost importance to us.

COVID-19 continues to change our daily lives. If you are entering this trial, be sure you are comfortable with our new guidelines and are willing to comply with physical distancing and wearing a mask. We suggest you acclimate your dog to seeing you wearing a mask before the trial.

If you do not wish to comply with these guidelines, we understand. These are strange times. You are welcome to join us at a future trial when things have returned to a state of normalcy.

Exhibitors not complying with these guidelines during the trial will be excused from the trial. No refunds will be given.
