## **Trial Format**

The trial will run rain or shine. There will be one outdoor, fully fenced and gated grass ring. Specials and Veterans will run **after** the Regular division in each of their respective classes.

## **Notice to Exhibitors**

Pre-registration is required. Entries must be sent to 5 Boulder Street, Little Britain, Ontario K0M 2C0, and received prior to 6:00 p.m. on September 3, 2010. **Confirmations will be emailed** and/or posted on our website no later than September 6, 2010.

This trial is being held under the Agility Association of Canada, Inc (AAC) Rules and Regulations. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they understand the AAC Rules and Regulations, including but not limited to the following:

1. This test is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression towards people or other dogs.
2. No leashes, collars, food or toys or other training aids/devices will be permitted on the course at any time.
3. Jump heights will be 6", 10", 16", 22" and 26".
4. There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, except for injured dogs or bitches that come into season. There will be no refunds in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless the reason.
5. Before they compete, all dogs must be registered with the Agility Association of Canada by having a valid AAC Dog Identification Card. Dogs without an AAC ID number will not receive credit for any legs earned.
6. Agility obstacles will be chosen from those described in the AAC Rule Book.
7. The trial's organizing committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
8. Move-ups from Friday to Saturday and Saturday to Sunday will be permitted if requested before the close of the trial the prior day. Other move-ups may be permitted at the discretion of the Trial Secretary.

## **Class Descriptions**

**AAC Starters Class:** The Starters class shall be for dogs not having earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title. A dog must achieve three clear rounds under at least two different judges to be awarded the ADC title.

**AAC Advanced Class:** The Advanced class shall be for dogs having earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title, but that have not earned the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada (AADC) title. A dog must achieve three clear rounds under at least two different judges to be awarded the AADC title.

**AAC Masters Class:** The Masters class shall be for dogs having earned the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada title. To be awarded the Master Agility Dog of Canada (MADC) title, a dog must achieve three clear rounds under at least two different judges.

**AAC Veterans Classes:** Veterans classes are for dogs seven years of age or older, or dogs five years and older who have been competing in Specials agility class for a minimum of one year.

**AAC Specials Classes:** Specials classes are open to all dogs. Handlers running a dog in Specials will have the option to move into Regular classes once during the dog's career. A switch from Specials to Regular cannot be made mid-trial. Dogs moving into Veterans or Specials from Regular classes take their titles with them.

**Games Classes:** Games classes are offered to Starters, Advanced and Masters dogs. Progression from one level to the next is as follows:

- Movement into an Advanced Game from a Starters Game requires two qualifying scores in that game at the Starters level earned under two different judges (or completion of one qualifying score in that game prior to January 1, 2009).
- Movement into a Masters game from an Advanced Game requires three qualifying scores in the game or, if earned prior to January 1, 2009, two qualifying scores in the game at the Advanced level under two different judges.

**AAC Steeplechase Class:** Steeplechase is open to dogs competing at all levels (Starters, Advanced and Masters).

**AAC Challenge Class:** Challenge is open only to dogs who have completed an AADC and are therefore eligible for Masters Standard courses.

## **Prizes and Awards**

All dogs with a qualifying score will be awarded a qualifying rosette. As well, in each of the Starters, Advanced, Masters and Games rounds, first to fourth place ribbons will be awarded in each height division. Title rosettes will be available for dogs that complete title requirements.

## About Daytripper Dog Training

Daytripper Dog Training is located in the City of Kawartha Lakes, Ontario, just east of the hamlet of Valentia, at the north end of Lake Scugog. We are conveniently located just 70 minutes from the DVP and 401, 20 minutes north of Port Perry, 10 minutes south/west of Lindsay and 45 minutes from Peterborough. Yes, our mailing address is Little Britain, however, we are south/east of the town. Our outdoor training facility is located on five country acres. We have one fully fenced and gated grass ring.

In order to help make everyone's visit a pleasant one, please observe a few simple rules:

1. Dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing in the ring or at the warm-up jump. Please keep dogs within the designated competitors' area – we like to give our personal dogs a bit of a buffer from all the excitement on trial days. Thanks.
2. Please clean up after your dog.
3. Please do not allow your dog to pee on the ring fence posts, garbage/recycle containers or anything else that people will be required to handle.
4. Please clean up after yourself. There will be ample garbage, recycling and butt containers available.
5. Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum. We really want to keep our neighbours happy.
6. **Drive very slowly** (max 5 km/h) and carefully while on the property. Please.
7. **Leave choke, prong and shock collars at home. This applies to competing and non-competing dogs.**
8. Leave bitches in heat at home.
9. Be nice to all judges, ring crew and fellow competitors.
10. Please volunteer to help. To keep the trial running smoothly and efficiently, we'll require the assistance of all participants. Every little bit helps! Whether you're sharing your experience or learning a new job, your contribution will be greatly appreciated.

## Accommodations

## The Fine Print: Assumption of risk, release and indemnity

I (we) agree that Daytripper Dog Training has the right to refuse this entry for any reason that the organizing committee deems sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, the holding of the event and/or the opportunity to have this dog participate or be judged, I (we) agree as follows:

- (i) while at or in proximity to this event, to freely assume all risk of loss (including death) or damage or injury, collectively called "Loss", to myself, this dog or any dog under my control, and to members of my family and my guests, and to our property;
- (ii) to release and discharge and to hold harmless and indemnify the organizing committee, the club and its directors, officers and members, the sanctioning body for this event (The Agility Association of Canada), sponsors of the event, and the owners of the premises or grounds upon which this event is held, and their respective employees and agents, collectively called the "Releasees", of and from any and all claims, and from all liability of any nature, for all Loss which I or this or any dog under my control or members of my family or my guests or our property may suffer for any reason or cause whatsoever, including specifically, but without limitation, all Loss resulting from the action or inaction of any dog, including this dog, or its owner or handler, or by the Releasees, or any of them, whether through negligence or otherwise. I expressly assume the risk and liability for all such Loss while attending or in proximity to this event and waive any and all claims relating thereto;
- (iii) to hold harmless and indemnify all Releasees, and each of them, of and from any and all claims by third parties, and from all liability of any nature, for all Loss, in relation to claims against me or through me, or against or through any member of my family or any other person accompanying me or attending as my guests or in my place, or arising as a result of any action or inaction by me or by this dog, or its owner or handler, or by any member of my family or any other person accompanying me or attending as my guests or in my place, or by the Releasees or any of them in relation thereto, whether through negligence or otherwise. I expressly assume all responsibility and liability for all such claims; and
- (iv) that all indemnities herein shall be full and complete indemnities, including legal costs on a solicitor and client basis.

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) have read, understand and will abide by the Official Rules and Regulations of the Agility Association of Canada, Inc. in effect at the time of this entry, and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list for this event. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. This entry is submitted for acceptance on the foregoing representation and Agreement. I (we) agree to conduct myself (ourselves) in accordance with such Rules and Regulations (including all provisions applying to discipline) and to abide by any decisions made in accordance with them.
